I: KEY SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS

- a) The school has officially closed for holidays today and each pupil has been given a report card, holiday package, circular and Bank slip
- b) **Completion of PLE**: The 2014 Primary Seven candidates successfully completed their PLE. We thank you for your prayers and support.
- c) **Graduatio**n: We had a colorful and fun- packed graduation for our Top Class on 15th November, 2015. Our graduands are now ready for yet another exciting academic journey in their primary education cycle.
- d) School sports day: We thank you for your full participation in the school's sports day that was held on 21st November 2015, it was one of those days in the year that we look forward to again interact with parents and school promoters.
- e) Habari Njema: Aware of the social, economic and political transformation that the East African region is currently experiencing, we can no longer hide from the glaring need to teach our children a regional dialect. I am pleased to inform you that our children are having a wonderful time learning Swahili language. The children are generally enthusiastic and love their second regional language
- f) Class days: The school continued to hold termly class days, a platform for teacherparent discussions in regard to the children's culture, discipline, co-curricular and academic rating. We continue to encourage all parents and guardians to always attend such events.
- g) **Internal and External Assessments**: Over the year our pupils have continued to be exposed to both internal and external assessments so as to enable them fit well in the

global world. The results clearly show that our children can confidently compete wherever they go.

- h) Religious instruction: The school has continued to accord opportunity for all children to grow spiritually and be grounded in their faith. In this regard, different religious leaders have continued to visit the school and offer spiritual food. Catholic communion lessons and confirmations were held.
- i) Corporate Social Responsibility: As we celebrated nine years of Little Muheji School in second term, we recognized the need to involve our children, staff and parents in corporate social responsibility. - m) **Swimming**: Fridays are swimming days. Interested parents pay 40,000/= per term for each child.

II: KEY REQUIREMENTS

- a) **One ream of Rota trim paper**: Each child should come with one ream of Rota trim paper on the reporting day.
- b) Fountain Pens: Pupils in P.3 P.7 classes will continue using fountain pens as usual.
- c) **Transport:** Pupils are picked and dropped at points of easy access and not their homes. Note that only pupils who have cleared transport dues to zero balance will be transported. Transport fees remain unchanged as for previous year.
- d) **Holiday work**: Each pupil has been given holiday work. Kindly provide guidance and return the signed work at the beginning of first term.
- e) **Escorting children on the First Day:** Parents/Guardians are required to bring their children to school on the first day of the term to make clearances and handover the child to the class teacher. Unaccompanied pupils will not be allowed in class.

f) School dues: Notwithstanding the increase in cost of goods and services mainly due to the dollar fluctuations, the school fees structure remains unchanged as last year. The school will work on innovative approaches to increase efficiency and value for money.
